
EVENT ORGANIZED: STORY WRITING COMPETETION


EVENT ORGANISED: Virtual Celebration of World Environment Day



BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT: -

World Environment Day was established by the UN General Assembly in 1972 on the first day of the Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment, resulting from discussions on the integration of human interactions and the environment. In 1974 the first World Environment Day was held with the theme "Only One Earth". World Environment Day is celebrated every year on June 5, to remind humans that they are not alone on this planet. The day is celebrated to raise global awareness about the significance of a healthy environment issues by implementing some actions to protect nature and earth, leading to a positive and healthy environment for all.

With this aim in view, the students and teachers of Department of Zoology, North Lakhimpur College (Autonomous) in association with Aaranyak and Zoological Society of Assam proposed to celebrate WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY, 5TH JUNE 2021 to create awareness among the students that will help in disseminating the knowledge to the community.

Due to the present situation caused by the pandemic, only two programmes were taken to be executed.

I. Plantation Drive

At 9 am in the morning, the Principal, Vice-principal, teachers and students of Department of Zoology along with the Forestry Officials (Social Forestry) of North Lakhimpur Division carried out a plantation programme. The site for the plantation was selected which is towards the western side of the College Campus where a new embankment was constructed by the PWD (Roads) a few months back. Almost a total of more than 50 species of endemic plants (Neem, Sia-Nahor etc.,) were planted during the Programme.

II. Popular Talk: -

To make the event more fruitful, a popular talk was organised at 3 pm. The resource person of the talk was Dr. Bibhab Kumar Talukdar founders and currently the Chief Executive Officer of Aaranyak. The topic of discussion was "Ecosystem Restoration: Challenges and opportunities". In his presentation the resource person very clearly in simple terms explained issues like environment degradation leading to imbalance in nature, the different steps that are to be taken for the restoration of the ecosystem, and the challenges that are being faced while trying to restore the ecosystem etc., He shared his experience about elephant restoration work that was carried out by his team in Java and Sumatra, grassland restoration work carried out in Manas Nation Park etc., Prof. Pryabrata Lahkar, the President of ZSA and Prof. J. C. Kalita, Secreatory of ZSA also spoke on the occasion.
