The Zoological Society of Assam (ZSA) unit of DK College and IQAC of DK College, Mirza organised a national webinar in collaboration with ZSA, Guwahati, on Saturday on the topic "Grassland Ecosystem- its significance, conservation and management". More than 325 participants from different parts of India, Malayasia and the Philippines took part in the webinar. Dr Bibhuti Prahad Lahkar, eminent scientist of NGO Aaranyak, who was the main speaker , stressed the need for conservation of grasslands, which is the habitat for a variety of indigenous species like the one-horned rhinoceros, pigmy hog, hispid hare, Bengal florican, water buffalo etc. He said that at present, large scale shrinkage of grassland due to

human settlement, agriculture, livestock grazing, unsystematic fire etc has become a great case of concern for ecologists, and all round efforts are needed from the government to make the conservation a people’s movement to save the degraded grasslands. Lahkar had won the IUCN World Heritage Hero Award in 2016 becoming the first Asian to get this honour for his contribution towards conservation of the Manas World Heritage site. He is a member of IUCN SSC Asian elephants specialist group and an expert member under Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and climate change. Dr Deepalee Das associate professor and Head of the Department of Zoology at DK College was the Coordinator of the webinar which was earlier inaugurated by Principal Nabajyoti Das. ZSA president Priyabrata Lahkar was the chef guest, while ZSA general secretary Prof Jogen Chandra Kalita spoke a few words on ZSA. Dr Arunabha Chakraborty assistant professor of Civil engineering at Tezpur University was also present.

International College (Bangkok, Thailand). Prof. Dr. Ramesh 'Zimbo' Boonratana is also the Vice-Chairman of IUCN SSC Primate Specialist Group and the Editor-in-Chief of the 'Asian Primates Journal'. Keynote address was presented by Prof. Manideep Raj co-ordinator of Zoological Society of Assam OER. His talk revolved around relevant facts right from Louis Pasteur's thoughts to books on pandemic published in the month of June. The webinar was attended by several educationists including prominent personalities like Priyabrata Lahkar, Dr. Balendra Kr. Das, Prof Jogen Ch. Kalita, faculty members of different universities and colleges, research scholars and students. Dr Chhandashree Bhuyan was the convenor and Dr. Manas Das, was the assistant convenor of the webinar. The title for the webinar has been taken from the 1966 Italian epic Spaghetti Western film directed by Sergio Leone, starring Clint Eastwood, Lee Van Cleef, and Eli Wallach and just like the Hollywood classic, the webinar too delivered an entertaining as well as educationally engaging interactive session. The ongoing pandemic situation has kept people locked down inside their homes and this webinar is exactly what a person working in the field of biodiversity got an opportunity to take their minds away from the gloominess that has surrounded almost everyone. The session revolved around the future research in the field of biodiversity in the post COVID world, what topics are going to emerge, which topics are going to be sidelined and what exactly are the opportunities that will open up once life gets back on track again. . An interaction was also held where the speaker attended to each query with a resolving attitude. 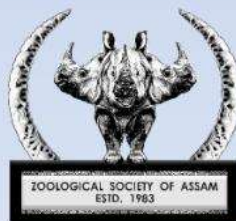

Zoology and Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Birjhora Mahavidyalaya, Bongaigaon association with Zoological Society of Assam (ZSA). The technical announcement of the Webinar was announced by Mr. Sanjib Baglary, IQAC, Coordinator, at 7.30 P.M. The welcome address was presented by Dr. K. K. Sarma, Principal, Birjhora Mahavidyalaya, Bongaigaon. The Webinar was Inaugurated by Prof. Jogen Chandra Kalita, Secretary, Zoological Society of Assam (ZSI) and Director, UGC-HRDC, G. U. He discussed various pros and cons of the Webinar. On behalf of the organizers, the Convener of Webinar, Dr. B. K. Saha invited the Chief Guest cum speaker, Prof. Achintya Bezbaruah, North Dakota State University, USA., to present his talk. Prof. Bezbaruah elaborately described how nano materials Arsenic (As) and Fluoride (F) has been reported to contaminate drinking water in Northeast India with special reference to Assam. Ground water contamination by As and F can result from the dissolution of minerals from subterranean strata. These inorganic contaminants in drinking water are known to cause serious health problems when the maximum contaminant levels exceed 0.05 mg/L for As and 1.5 mg/L for F. Arsenic mainly causes cancer and fluoride dental problems and other diseases. He also demonstrated how Arsenic and Fluoride can be removed by different techniques from drinking water. He has also delivered ideas about how research and projects can be developed on purification of Drinking water such as how purified drinking water can be available at Water ATM? The president ZSA, Mr. Priyabrata Lahakar, also welcome the chief guests and delivered valuable speech about the webinar. Dr. Manideep Raj, Coordinator, Open Educational Resources (OER), ZSA and Associate Prof. in Zoology, Darrang College, Tezpur for his valuable speech on activities of Zoological Society of Assam during the lock down period.
