The Zoological Society of Assam (ZSA) has instituted Dr Balit Kumar Deka Memorial Award from 2018 in memory of Dr Deka, a former Head of the Department of Zoology, Cotton College. The award is bestowed in memory of Dr Deka to a student who secures highest marks among the Zoology major students of the State in the BSc final examination appearing from any one of the universities of Gauhati, Dibrugarh, Bodoland and Assam University. The award carries a cash award of Rs 10,000 and a certificate of appreciation from the ZSA.

she has been working in Dadara, Pachariya and Shingimari villages to save the endangered bird locally known as hargila.

Dr Lahkar was honoured as IUCN's Heritage Hero. He is the first Asian to be given this prestigious honour for enormous contributions towards conservation of Nature and natural resources. He has been working to save the grasslands, flora and fauna of the Manas National Park for the past 20 years.
